Pewamo-Westphalia Community Schools Library of Things - Guidelines for Borrowing and Use

Objects lent out by the Library through its Library of Things program must be checked out from and returned to the circulation desk at the Pewamo-Westphalia MS/HS library at 5101 Clintonia Rd., Westphalia, MI. Things may not be returned at any other district location.

A valid PW Schools library account in good standing (no fines or overdue materials in excess of \$5) is required to borrow a Thing. Borrowers of Things must be students or staff members of the schools. Borrowing is limited to one Thing at a time per patron (with the exception of the Christmas Tree kit).

LOAN PERIODS AND FINES

In most cases, a Thing may be borrowed for one week and renewed one week at a time after unless another borrower is waiting. The overdue fine will be \$0.10 per day.

PROPER USE AND LIABILITY

Use care when handling a Thing. The borrower is solely responsible for the Thing and will be billed for reasonable repair or replacement costs associated with damage or loss of Things due to neglect or abuse. The Library has sole discretion in making these decisions.

A list of replacement costs of Things is maintained by the Library and is available upon request. A list of replacement costs will also be provided in the case for each Thing.

The responsibility to protect against loss is the borrower's. Library aides will inspect Things prior to borrowing and again upon return. Patrons will be responsible for any damage to a Thing while in their possession.
