APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- 1. Limited applications are being accepted for students in grades BK through 12th grade (except 5th) for the 2025-2026 school year.
- 2. All applications will be screened for accurate information. This may involve contacting the school district previously attended.
- 3. Your acceptance is conditional until Pewamo-Westphalia Community Schools receives and reviews all school reports and determines there are available spaces in the appropriate grade.
- 4. If the number of applications for a specific grade level or program exceeds the number of available spaces, applicants will be selected through a lottery process and must meet all other SOC requirements.
- 5. If a SOC applicant for Pewamo-Westphalia Community Schools has a sibling who is currently enrolled at P-W and the District is accepting SOC students in the applicant's grade level, the applicant will have priority status for that grade and will not be subject to the lottery if there are enough openings in the requested grade. If multiple SOC applicants have siblings enrolled at P-W, a drawing may be held for the applicants if the number of applicants is greater than the number of openings. The applicant must meet all eligibility requirements.
 - a. In the case of a situation where the number of applicants with siblings who are currently enrolled with P-W Schools is greater than the number of openings at that grade level, there will be a lottery for those students.
- 6. The Pewamo-Westphalia Community Schools **registration** process for approved students must be **completed by Friday**, **June 27, 2025.** If students are not registered by these dates, Pewamo-Westphalia Community Schools will assume that the application for SOC has been withdrawn.
- 7. a.) If your child is currently eligible for special education services and <u>you reside outside of the Clinton County RESA area</u>. (outside of Pewamo-Westphalia, Bath, Dewitt, St. Johns, Fowler, Ovid Elsie) Pewamo-Westphalia Community Schools is required to secure a cooperative agreement regarding reimbursement for special education costs from your resident district in order to register your child in our school district.
 - b.) If <u>you reside outside of the Clinton County RESA area</u>, (outside of Bath, Dewitt, St. Johns, Fowler, Pewamo-Westphalia, Ovid Elsie), and your child is found to be eligible for special education services <u>after</u> admission to the Pewamo-Westphalia School District, please be advised that the district is required to obtain a cooperative agreement regarding reimbursement for special education costs from your resident district in order for your child to remain in our school district.
- 8. Once registered, students may remain in the Pewamo-Westphalia School District until graduation if the student complies with all guidelines for SOC. The only exceptions are cited in 7b above or under *Code of Conduct* below.
- 9. Athletic eligibility at the secondary level may be affected. Students who transfer by choice from one school to another and do not otherwise satisfy the transfer regulation are ineligible for interscholastic athletics for one full semester. ATTENDANCE

Students are expected to arrive and depart from school on time. It is expected that parents will pick up students on time when they are attending an after school or evening event.

CODE OF CONDUCT

All Student Code of Conduct rules, procedures, and policies will apply to all students who enter Pewamo-Westphalia Community Schools under the SOC guidelines and procedures (see student handbooks).

TRANSPORTATION

Parents of SOC students are expected to provide transportation to and from school for their students. SOC parents may arrange with our Transportation Department for pick up and drop off locations within our district boundaries (please see transportation request form). GRADE PLACEMENT

All Begindergarten and Kindergarten students will be readiness-level tested. District discretion will be utilized for placement.
